

## #4: Challenge Series: Using Coding Conventions

### Case Question:

A 57-year-old Hispanic male presented to the Medical Eye Service clinic for a retinal evaluation of diabetic retinopathy. He reported vision that fluctuated only in the morning and poorer vision in the right eye. He was diagnosed with type II diabetes mellitus 15 years ago and is currently taking Glucophage. The patient was diagnosed with severe nonproliferative diabetic retinopathy, OD greater than OS, and was advised to schedule grid laser treatment at his earliest convenience.

How should this case be coded using ICD-10-CM and its coding conventions? \_\_\_\_\_
